

Your introduction to GOING GREEN with WASTE PRO®

Beginning Friday, May 1, 2009, Waste Pro® will be your new garbage service provider.

Important information about your new service is listed below.
A comprehensive overview of acceptable recycling materials is listed on the back.

YOUR PICK UP SCHEDULE WILL REMAIN THE SAME.

There will be no change in your regular garbage and recycling service days. If you do not know your schedule, please contact 407-599-3220.

NEW CONTAINERS ARE ON THE WAY!

Beginning Monday, April 20, new containers will start to be delivered.

Please leave your old 96-gallon garbage container(s) curbside during the week of April 20 the day that you normally receive recycling services. If the container is not picked up by 7 p.m., please place it curbside for removal on the same day the following week.

You will keep your existing recycling bin(s) unless you have ordered a recycling cart.

If you use a 96-gallon yard waste container(s), please leave it curbside during the week of April 20 the day that you normally receive yard waste services. If the container is not picked up by 7 p.m., please place it curbside for removal on the same day the following week.

General Information

- All garbage, recycle and yard waste must be placed out at the curb between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Please do not mix household waste, hazardous waste, yard waste or recyclable products.

Holidays (no collection)

*Any pickup service that would fall on a holiday listed above will be provided on the next regularly scheduled pick-up day following the holiday.

Recycle pickup will be provided on New Year's Day.

Garbage Collection

- Household refuse will be picked up twice a week. Please place all items curbside in one centrally located spot. Residents who are physically unable to place household refuse curbside may contact the city at 407-599-3220 for rear- or side-yard pickup.
- Hazard waste material such as paint, insecticides, motor oil, gasoline and batteries as well as other hazardous waste materials need to be disposed properly.

Recycle Collection

Recycle collection will be provided one day per week.

- Please recycle items with a #1, #2 or #3 symbol
- Newspaper and magazines
- Glass jars, soda, milk and water bottles
- Aluminum and tin cans
- Plastic soda, milk and water bottles

Yard Waste Collection

Yard waste collection will be provided one day per week.

Palm fronds, tree limbs and other yard waste material not placed in a container must be securely tied and bundled before being placed curbside. The length of each bundle should not exceed four feet or weigh more than 50 pounds.

Through this innovative program, Winter Park residents are able to recycle office materials along with their residential pickup. How does it work? Simply include your office and business recyclables from the list below in your bin or cart. Waste Pro will collect them curbside. S.C.O.R.E. ~ just another way to help your community Go Green.

Quick reference of acceptable materials for home, office or business recycling

Aluminum: beverage containers, foil, casserole pans and pie plates

Cans: steel, tin and empty aerosol cans

Plastic bottles: pet containers such as soda bottles, dishwashing soap and shampoo bottles; hdpe natural and colored containers such as milk jugs, water bottles and detergent bottles.

Labels are acceptable.

For maximum efficiency, please rinse the above items and remove the original contents, labels, lids and plastic caps. These items will not be rejected if they are not rinsed.

Paper and cardboard: All loose newspaper, corrugated containers that are flattened, cut down or folded to 4' x 4' flattened and 2'x2' square. Brown paper or craft paper bags, telephone books, magazines, catalogs and glossy print publications; paperboard such as cereal boxes, drink/snack boxes and wax-coated paperboard; mixed use residential and office paper; shredded paper, junk mail, computer and school paper, envelopes and manila folders.

Not accepted for recycling: Plastic bags
Plastic tubs
Garbage
